[GENERAL GUIDELINES]

EXCELERATE INTERNSHIP has adopted general rules and regulations necessary for growth as well as unity. This will allow each student to form habits consistent with a Godly lifestyle.

No discipline seems pleasant at the time, but painful. Later on, however, it produces a harvest of righteousness and peace for those who have been trained by it.

Hebrews 12:11

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- No illicit drugs, alcohol, or tobacco (cigarettes). None!
- No profanity.
- No fighting (verbal or physical)
- No secular music.
- No romantic, emotional, or physical dating relationships during the 1st year program. This is consistently enforced and will be cause for immediate dismissal from the program.
- Absolutely no pairing off (guy / girl).
- Do not attend any clubs or bars...immediate dismissal!
- Curfew: 12:00 a.m.

DISCIPLINE

If a student fails to comply with the rules set forth in the program, he or she will receive a warning. After the first verbal warning the student will be placed on probation. The minimum probationary period is one month; however, probation time length may vary depending on the severity of the violation. If the student violates probation he or she may be asked to leave the program. If a student is dismissed, no refund will be given and the remaining balance (if any) will be due upon his or her departure. There are no exceptions!

CONDUCT

It is expected that all students conduct themselves according to a Godly lifestyle; and one that represents EXCELERATE INTERNSHIP and its standards. Any questionable acts or blatant disobedience will not be tolerated. When a student's actions are in question, disciplinary measures will be taken and may lead to probation or even dismissal from the program.

SCHEDULES

The daily schedule will be the same with the exception of traveling or ministry seasons.

DATING RELATIONSHIPS

Dating relationships with anyone in or outside the program during an intern's first year with the EXCELERATE INTERNSHIP is prohibited. It is important that each student focus on the Lord and His purposes for his or her life. The first year of an intern program is one of great change, challenge and several distractions. Here at

EXCELERATE we would like to ensure the success, as much as, possible of our students academically, in their endeavors in ministry, and relationships. This guideline is set up to allow time for each student to adjust to the change and fast paced schedule of the program.

As a part of EXCELERATE INTERNSHIP all interns must be above reproach in all relationships with the opposite sex. This includes submitting his or her relationships to the standard of the Word of God. All relationships must be approached in an open and honest manner. Before entering into a dating relationship it is expected that the Pastors are made aware and included in on this process. It is unacceptable under any circumstances for any intern to date or have a dating type relationship with a student (this is means for immediate dismissal).
