[What is expected]

We are excited about Youth Convention! It is a great time where we can get to know each other as well as see God move in our lives. In order for you to have the full experience of Youth Convention, we require the following things from you as the attendee.

- You are an example of Jesus, and must exhibit behavior as such on this trip. Disciplinary action WILL take place if behavior that is contrary to this is displayed at any time during this trip. (see below)
- While at Youth Convention, you MUST notify a leader if you are leaving the group for any reason (ie, bathroom etc.), groups of no smaller than 3 are allowed to leave and MUST be accompanied by a leader.
- You will honor and respect the adults on this trip, as they are giving up their time and energy to attend this trip with us. On this trip, they have the same authority as the youth pastor, and any negative behavior to any of the adults will result in an immediate call to a parent to pick you up.

[Disciplinary action]

If in the event that disciplinary action needs to be taken on the attendee for any reason, the following consequences will take place.

- 1) The student will be given a verbal warning by the youth pastor
- 2) If behavioral issues continue, the student will spend the remainder of the time at Youth Convention with the youth pastor
- 3) If there is a further issue, the parent will be contacted to come and pick up their student at their expense.

Student/Parent Conduct Agreement

(Please photocopy as needed for each student/parent)

1. We are glad that you have chosen to attend Youth Convention 2010. We have been praying that this weekend will dramatically change your life!
2. Your youth pastor/leader and your counselors will strictly enforce the 12:30 a.m. curfew.
3. No girls are allowed in guys' rooms; no guys are allowed in girls' rooms (except for devotions as supervised by your counselor).
4. You must remain with your group at all times. If a counselor finds that you are missing, and can't find you for more than 1/2 hour, your parents will be notified of your absence, and disciplinary actions will follow.
5. Always respect the hotel's property, and also respect the other guests that are roomed near you. No running in the halls, no "prank calling" other rooms, no throwing anything out of windows... These are luxury hotels—act accordingly. You will be held responsible to pay for any damages you cause.
6. You are responsible to wear your wristband throughout the entire weekend. If you lose or forget your wristband your youth pastor will have to purchase another one for \$5.00.
7. No public display of affection (PDA).
8. Once services begin NO ONE will be permitted to exit the building.
9. Government/Convention statement: No fireworks, smoking, drinking of alcoholic beverages, drugs, or profanity allowed.
10. The lack of cooperation, unnecessary roughness, lack of respect of property, or an unwholesome attitude on the part of any person will result in expulsion from the convention. Parents are expected to assist in explaining these rules to their youth and encourage their compliance while at the convention. Expense of transporting expelled persons home from the convention will be the responsibility of the parents.
